KEYNOTE SPEAKERS



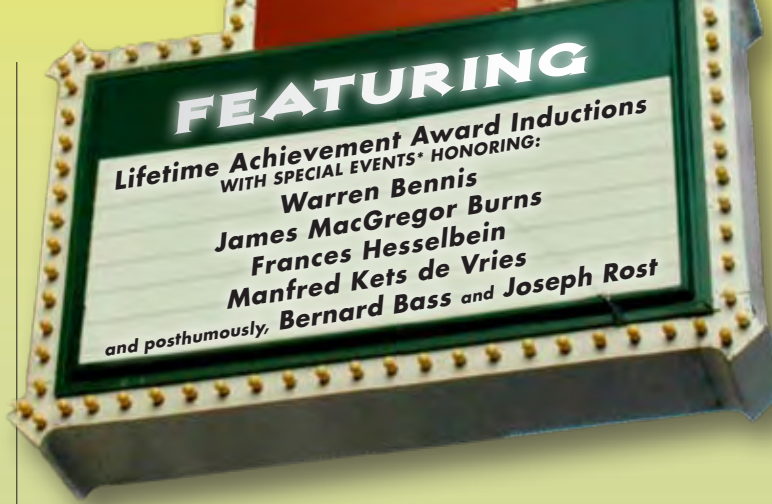
CHRISTINE LOH, a former elected member of the Hong Kong Legislative Council, is the co-founder and Chief Executive Officer of the independent, non-profit public policy think tank Civic Exchange. She writes extensively about politics, energy/climate change, and sustainable development and has been widely published in Hong Kong and abroad.

CONNIE RICE is renowned for her unconventional approaches to tackling problems of inequity and exclusion. Rice has received more than 50 major awards for her leadership of diverse coalitions and her non-traditional approaches to litigating major cases involving police misconduct, employment discrimination, and fair public resource allocation. In 2006, *Los Angeles Times West Magazine* named Rice one of the 100 most powerful people in Southern California.
