

Leadership Learning Community ("LLC") is a national organization that believes leadership is the site of transformation. We know efforts in diversity, inclusion, and race equity are important for changing the systems in place, and alone, they are not enough to uproot oppressive practices and advance the transformation we seek. Additionally, our social good sector is experiencing high rates of burnout, becoming a revolving door for people of color and perpetuating physical, mental, spiritual, and emotional duress. We believe it's time to hold more spaces grounded in collective liberation. To do this, we facilitate and encourage the unlearning of oppressive structures, the engagement of communities of practice that create new cultural norms, and the development of tools and frameworks that allow us to align our values and actions. We work with leaders globally, particularly those from historically excluded communities such as Black, Indigenous, immigrant, people of color, LGBTQIA+, and people with disabilities, and invite them to live out the compelling vision of liberation - one which seeks power, joy, and thriving for all people. Together, we create spaces for leaders to run, fund, and study practices rooted in collective liberation (rather than systemic oppression). We call this liberatory leadership.
